Colonel Tina H. Nguyen is Deputy Director of Financial Management and Comptroller for the Air Force Life Cycle Management Center, Air Force Materiel Command, Wright-Patterson AFB, OH. Col Nguyen assists the Director in training and equipping 1,647 financial personnel, as well as providing oversight and advice regarding funds under management worth \$255B across the Center. She also assists in policy formulation, interpretation, and implementation, providing executive supervision with regard to budget execution and centralized cost estimating management, influencing over 3,000 programs/projects valued in excess of \$1T.

Commissioned through AFROTC at the University of Washington in 1997, Col Nguyen has had financial management assignments at base, center, and major command levels, as well as several career broadening tours. She deployed to Iraq as a team chief in Resource Management in the Gulf Region Division in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, and also to Afghanistan as the Air Advisor to the Afghan Air Force Comptroller in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM and Operation FREEDOM'S SENTINEL.

Prior to assuming her current position, Col Nguyen was dual-hatted as the Financial Management Acquisition Leader for Wright-Patterson AFB, where she mentored 24 FM CGOs, and as the Chief Financial Officer, F-15 ACAT I Modernization, where she oversaw the budget and cost for the \$7B electronic warfare upgrade for the F-15.
